**2006 IBC Wood Framing Provisions**

**Description:**

Introduces the subject of building design as applied to wood-frame building construction. Although centered on building design, also focuses on trusses, framing, wood structural panels, connection details and physical and mechanical properties of wood.

**Objectives:**

Upon completion, participants will be able to:

- Distinguish between vertical loads and horizontal loads.
- Identify characteristics of wood properties.
- Describe horizontal framing member designs.
- Inspect trusses for construction installation compliance.
- Identify three basic wood panel designs.
- Explain floor-framing requirements.
- Identify correct wall framing.
- Determine size and spacing of ceiling joist and rafters.
- Identify types of wood connectors.
